Most states require inspections

Virtually all states have requirements for the periodic inspection of boilers and pressure vessels to ensure that equipment is in good working order. Codes vary from state to state, but generally boilers and other pressure equipment must be inspected by commissioned inspectors at specified intervals for continued operation. The law or regulations might also require a certificate that attests the equipment complies with these requirements. HSB inspectors are familiar with the rules and requirements for jurisdictional inspections in your location.

How do you know if you need a jurisdictional inspection?

If you answer "yes" to any of the following questions, you might need an inspection:

- Do you have a heating or process boiler?
- Do you have a large (200,000 Btu) water heater?
- Do you have a pressure vessel, such as a commercial air tank or hot water tank?
