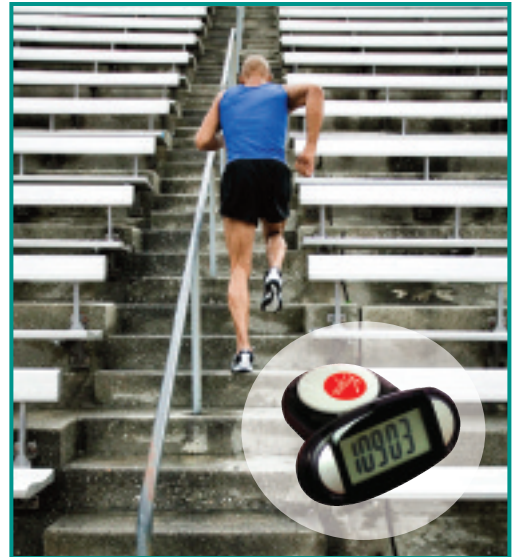




Get in the GoZone

Your GoZone pedometer tracks your steps and your progress toward better health. To ensure peak performance from your GoZone, follow these tips:

- **Get strapped for safety!** Don't forget to attach the GoZone safety strap to a belt loop, belt or sock. While the GoZone can be replaced for \$24.99 on the Virgin HealthMiles Web site, it's best to find an attachment suitable for yours! Note: you may have to use a bit more force than you'd expect to open the clip and hook the pedometer onto your waistband or shoe. Don't be afraid to put a bit of muscle into it!
- **Unleash the power.** Your GoZone comes with a clear plastic tag protecting its battery. Make sure the tag is removed before trying to activate your GoZone. Also, the pedometer will show five zeros (**00000**) until you register it to your account. Not getting any credit for your steps? Be sure you followed the instructions on the package to properly register your GoZone.
- **Don't lose it.** If you accidentally clear the GoZone display by pressing the SET button, fear not—your steps are not lost! Your GoZone can store step data for two weeks (up to 99,999 steps) between Web site uploads.
- **Customize your count.** Look on the GoZone package insert for tips on customizing the distance, calorie count and time on your pedometer by using tools at the bottom of the page under "**Customize your GoZone Stats.**" This information is also available on the HealthMiles Web site under **Activity Tracking Devices/GoZone Pedometer Support.**
- **Handle with care.** Remember: Your GoZone is not waterproof—protect it from the elements, and don't take it in the pool.

- USB 1.1 capabilities
- Windows® 98SE, 2000, Me, XP, or Vista operating system
- Internet connection and Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.0 or above (or compatible browser)
