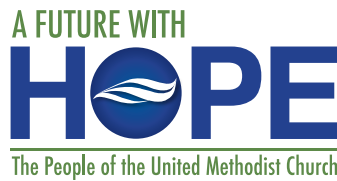


Superstorm Sandy was four years ago, but more than 4,000 families have still not recovered. Show your gratitude this Thanksgiving by giving your time and talents to those in need.
