Directions:

From South Jersey

Take I-295 northbound:

1. North to Exit 36A, Route 73 South (first exit ramp). Stay in right lane on Rt. 73.

2. Approx. 500 feet, go through first traffic light, take first jug handle and cross over Rt. 73 to Fellowship Road.

3. Continue on Fellowship Road to the fourth (4) light and turn left on to Pleasant Valley Avenue.

4. Continue on Pleasant Valley Ave., straight through 1st light (Rt. 38), go through 2nd light (Kings Hwy) and the church is on the left at the end of the road at the intersection of Pleasant Valley and Camden Avenues.

From North Jersey / Trenton / Willingboro / Etc.

Take I-295 southbound:

1. South to exit 40. Take first exit to Route 38 West.

2. Continue until the fifth traffic light (Strawbridge Lake on right).

3. Turn right onto Pleasant Valley Avenue. Continue on Pleasant Valley Ave.

4. Cross over traffic light (Kings Highway). Church is on the left at the end of the road at the intersection of Pleasant Valley & Camden Avenues.

From Camden / Pennsauken /Collingswood

Take Route 30 to Route 38 East:

1. Continue East on Route 38 for approximately five (5) miles until you come to the Moorestown Mall (Classic Chevrolet on the right).

2. Get in left lane. At the third (3) traffic light, turn left on to Pleasant Valley Avenue.

3. Continue on Pleasant Valley Ave.

4. Cross over traffic light (Kings Hwy). Church is on the left at the end of the road at the intersection of Pleasant Valley & Camden Avenues.
