



SCHOLARSHIPS

The Educational Society of the United Methodist Church or Greater New Jersey (GNJ) awards scholarships to students who are matriculated in an accredited theological seminary or graduate school and who agree to serve full time for at least five years as a member of the United Methodist Church or Greater New Jersey under appointment by the Bishop.

LOANS

The Educational Society of the United Methodist Church or Greater New Jersey provides loans of up to \$5,000 annually to students preparing for Christian service. Each candidate must be matriculated in an accredited college, seminary or graduate school.

APPLICATION

Application requests will be accepted after February 1.

An application consists of:

- Scholarship and loans application completed in full and signed by the applicant.
- Official request for assistance signed by the applicant and district superintendent.
- Certificate of recommendation completed by the Administrative Board/Council secretary and pastor of applicant's home church.
- Official transcripts of college and graduate classes.
- Two references.
