#### What is a community asset?

A community asset (or community resource) is anything that can be used to improve the quality of community life. And this means:

- It can be a *person*
- It can be a physical structure or place
- It can be a community service
- It can be a business or organization
- You and everyone else in the community are potential community assets.


What is Asset Mapping? Why is Asset Mapping Helpful? Asset Mapping: Two Approaches
