Week 1: God Is On the Move

Genesis 1:1-8

Genesis 12:1-9

Sometimes movement can be uncomfortable. Faith requires that we face obstacles trusting in the plan of God.

Week 3: (Mother's Day) Mountains as Opportunities

Luke 1:39-45

Both Mary and Elizabeth have been swept over by God's spirit, which has led to the unlikely motherhood of both. We are reminded that nothing is impossible with God.

Week 4: You Move the Mountain

Hebrews 12: 1-2

The mountains you face might be obstacles to overcome, but they can also be opportunities for you to step out. But, with God, none of these mountains are impossible for you to move.
